General Diving

Do I need to be certified to dive?

No. We welcome both beginners and certified divers.

We offer : Try Scuba for first-timers, Fun dives for certified divers, All SSI courses from open water to advanced

Where do you dive?

We dive on beautiful reefs around Le Pirate Island - Gili Lontar and nearby sites, reached by short boat rides. Expect clear waters, healthy soft and hard coral, turtles, reef fish, and occasionally larger marine life depending on the season

What are the water temperature and visibility?

- Water temperature : 27 - 29°C
- Visibility : typically 15 - 30 meters, depending on conditions

Is diving available all year round?

Yes. Diving is available year-round, although conditions may vary slightly depending on season and weather

For Beginners

I've never dived before. Can I try?

Absolutely. Our Try Scuba experience is designed for beginners and includes :

- A short theory briefing
- Shallow water practice
- One guided dive with a certified professional diver
- No previous experience required

Is try scuba safe?

Yes. Beginner dives are conducted :

- With a certified professional diver
- In calm, shallow conditions
- In small groups for comfort & safety

What is the minimum age to dive?

- The hotel do not accept children under 16 years old. So no restriction here

For Certified Divers

Which certifications do you accept?

We accept all internationally recognized certifications, including PADI, SSI, CMAS, NAUI, and others

Do I need to bring my certification card?

Yes. A digital or physical certification card is required before diving.

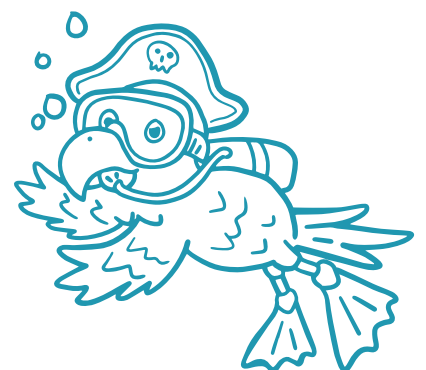
How many dives can I do per day?

Typically :

- 2 dives per day comfortably
- Additional dives may be possible depending on conditions and scheduling.

Do you offer night dives?

Yes. Night dives are available, depending on conditions and diver experience.



Equipment & Practical Information

Is diving equipment included?

Yes. All dive packages include full diving equipment:

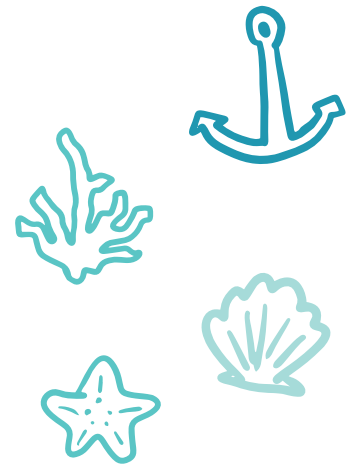
• BCD • Regulator • Wetsuit • Mask & fins • Weights & tank

Should I bring my own equipment?

You're welcome to bring your own gear if you prefer, but it is not required

What wetsuit thickness do you use?

We generally use 3mm wetsuits, suitable for local water temperatures



Health & Safety

Do I need to fill in a medical form?

Yes. All divers must complete a standard diving medical questionnaire before diving

What if I have a medical condition?

Some conditions may require doctor's clearance. If in doubt, please contact us before your stay

How long should I wait before flying after diving?

- After a single dive : minimum 12 hours
- After multiple dives or multiple days : 18 - 24 hours

Booking & Payments

Do I need to book dives in advance?

As a small, island-based dive shop, we keep our dive scheduling flexible to adapt to weather & sea conditions. Simply let us know your interest, and Signature Scuba team will organize your dives once you arrive

Is a deposit required to book dives?

No advance booking or deposit is required. All dive activities are confirmed and paid for on the island

Can non-divers join the dive boat?

For safety and space reasons, non-divers are generally not allowed on dive boats

Environment & Responsibility

Do you follow eco-friendly diving practices?

Yes. We are committed to responsible diving and ask all divers to:

- Avoid touching coral or marine life
- Maintain good buoyancy
- Respect the marine environment
